**Position Summary:** Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of skilled duties to maintain complex manufacturing, production and process equipment. Installs, troubleshoots, repairs and modifies equipment and systems where knowledge of interrelationships among various supporting processes and components is essential.

### **Key Responsibilities/Requirements:**

#### 1. Proof Programs

- Read code to detect code errors prior to running to prevent crash moves and incorrect part manufacture
- Trouble shoot / error detect programs at machine control
- Analyze cutter performance issues
- Make Speed/Feed/Tooling recommendations for process improvement / corrective actions

2. Responsible for running Vericut and other verification software for error detection prior to proof.

3. Implements new processes and process improvements with some direction and guidance of the programmer and production manager, proving out these processes.

4. Responsible for maintaining the operational capability of assigned equipment and processes, including machine calibration.

5. Works from limited documentation as required. May provide work guidance to lower level technicians and/or machine operators.
