Position Summary:

Under limited to general supervision, operates and sets-up a variety of machine tool equipment to extremely close and complex tolerances including CNC Horizontal Mills and Five Axis Mills.

Essential Functions:

- Runs and performs set-ups in multi-axis CNC Horizontal Mills to extremely close and complex tolerances.
- Reads and interprets blueprints, production diagrams and assembly drawings.
- Checks height, depth and thickness using micrometers, dial indicators, calipers, gauges and other precision-measuring instruments.
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
- Responsible for prompt and regular attendance as scheduled.
- Makes complex measurements and advanced shop math calculations.
- May inspect fabricated parts.
- May be required to work on "first time" projects
- May provide computer numerical control programming support.
- May participate in process development activities.
- May set-up and make "first-article" check on difficult production runs.
- May participate in defining strategies to meet quality objectives and in system reviews within the team.
- Participates in team meetings as required (safety, problem solving, etc.).
- May rotate into other positions within the team as required to meet production requirements.
- May participate in training of new team members.
- May participate in Arnprior's selection process.
- Problem-solves individually or as part of a group as job duties require.
- May be required to work overtime.
